



TOWN OF ADDISON

WARRANT FOR TOWN MEETING

To, Irvin Pinkham, constable for the Town of Addison in the County of Washington and the State of Maine:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the said Town of Addison, in the said County of Washington, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to assemble at the Addison Town Hall in said Town of Addison on December 3, 2018, at six o'clock in the evening, then and there to act upon the following articles, to wit:

Article 1. To choose a Moderator to preside over said meeting.

Article 2. To see if the Town will adopt the rules of procedure set forth in the *Maine Moderator's Manual* for the governance of this meeting.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the transfer of \$15,000. from Unappropriated Surplus to the Dangerous Buildings account to pay for legal expenses already incurred and legal expenses anticipated in the towns defense of the 'Town of Addison vs. Kelsey' case.

Explanation: \$5,000 was budgeted for the Dangerous Buildings Account in March of 2018. \$11,549.48 has been expended, leaving an overage of \$6,549.48. Additional legal expenses are anticipated at an estimate (provided by Rudman Winchell) of \$7,958.00.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the transfer of \$15,000. from Unappropriated Surplus to the Legal Expenses account to pay for unanticipated legal expenses.
